VOLUNTEER POSITIONS – Please check all of the volunteer positions which you are interested in. Volunteer positions will be selected and then we will notify you of your position by email.

- Court Sweeper: Volunteers will be required to stand at the end of the court with a broom mop and sweep the court if players make contact with it.
- Accreditation: Volunteers will be required to distribute accreditation to teams, coaches and staff.
- Parking: Volunteers will help to assist cars into empty parking spots as well as direct the flow of traffic in the lot to ensure safety.
- Spectator Seating Servicing: Volunteers will be required to distribute the swag and programs to guests of the event which outline the details of the event.
- General Information: Volunteers will provide guests with basic information such as food and beverage services as well as general direction.
- Hospitality Support: Volunteers will be required to provide hospitality services to sponsors, as well as provide any other services needed.
- Team Services: Volunteers will be required to provide tasks for the team to ensure they are comfortable and their needs are served.
- Area Supervisors: Volunteers will be required to check accreditation at all points of athlete zones and ensure spectators are kept out of restricted areas.
- Locker Room Assistant: Volunteers will be on court at quarter- and half-time, to engage with the guests and act as a MC for half time events.
- Game-Ops Assistant: Volunteers will be on court at quarter- and half-time, to engage with the guests and act as a MC for half time events.
- On-Court Assistant: Volunteers will be on court to help manage on-court elements of the game and maintain a safe playing area.
- Student Experience: Volunteers will be meeting students at pick-up and drop-off points, handing out game tickets and drink tickets, and ensuring students arrive to and from the game on provided buses.
- Package Administration: Volunteers will be in charge of distributing club packages and supervising the practice experience.
